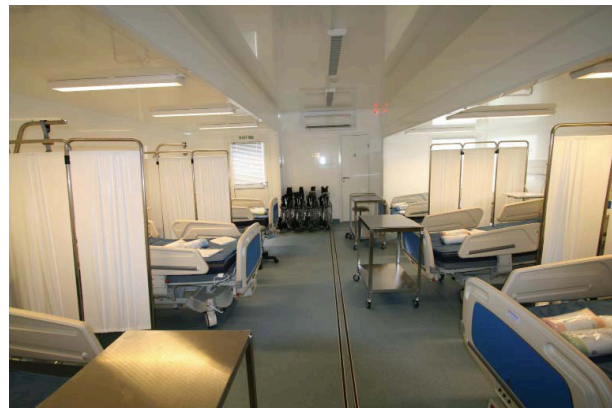
Semi-permanent scalable mobile hospitals



Semi-permanent hospitals are constructed within a matter of weeks, collapsed for future use elsewhere, and last for up to 30 years. Most recently, a hospital system of over 100 “Flat Pack” container units was contracted by Doctors Without Borders to establish a lasting presence in Haiti, after the 2010 Earthquake. We have also delivered these systems in Thailand after the 2004 Tsunami, in Pakistan after the 2005 earthquake, and in Sudan in 2008 after the genocide.

The hospital units are prefabricated and delivered under a short time frame as “turn key” projects. They are resistant to earthquakes and other hazards, such as severe weather. They are customized with options, such as medical staff, security, and supplies, as well as catering, residential, and bathroom facilities. Infrastructure is provided as needed, including drilling wells for a clean water supply and construction of sewage tanks.
